Restaurants Approved for Landmark Shangri-La Hotel

Santa Monica's landmark Shangri-La Hotel will soon reopen with two new restaurants and portable poolside bar area in its newly refurbished facilities. The 7-story hotel, which is on the City's Historic Resources Inventory List, was built in 1939 as an apartment hotel. Two years ago the City's Planning Commission approved plans for its owners to convert the hotel's suites to standard hotel rooms. However, the owners decided to return to the Commission on August 20 to add restaurants to the list of amenities the hotel wishes to offer.

Hotel Project Manager, Nadar Al Fara, explained to the Commission that the reason the hotel wanted to add the restaurants was so that they could try "to receive a 4 star rating from AAA."
